# RESTAURANT INSPECTIONS

At least once a year, Erie County Department of Health officials inspect all restaurants and stores that sell unpackaged food. Here is a list of violations recorded April 24 through Wednesday. For a first look at the list, go to GoErie.com every Thursday.

#### **3 CRITICAL VIOLATIONS**

Chuck E. Cheese, 7200 Peach St., Summit Township. (Person in Charge not performing required duties; pink slime and black mold found inside ice machine bin and on soda machine ice dispenser; salad bar cooler not keeping food cold enough.) Also 3 noncritical violations. Tuesday.

#### **2 CRITICAL VIOLATIONS**

Dairy Queen, 4501 Pine Ave. (Reach-in cooler not keeping food cold enough; Pepsi cooler not keeping food cold enough.) Also 1 noncritical violation. Monday.

## **HOW THEY'RE GRADED**

Inspectors use these terms to describe violations:

■Critical violation: Likely to contribute to food contamination or food-borne illness. The Health Department has the authority to close the facility until it is corrected

■Noncritical violation: Less likely to cause contamination or illness but is undesirable in a food establishment. Inspectors could give owners a day, week or month to correct the violation.

■Significant noncompliance: A number of noncritical violations that together pose a risk to public health. Inspectors consider it a critical violation.

■ Previous violations corrected: The facility had violations but has since fixed them.
