## 3 vie for city paving pact

Erie's Joseph McCormick Construction Co. Inc. has submitted a low bid of nearly \$1.3 million to

The bid by McCormick Construction, 3340 Pearl Ave., is for paving and milling work, as well as some curb ramp repairs. McCormick's bid was the lowest of three submitted to the city, according to information provided by City Engineer Jon Tushak's office.

Two other construction firms, Mayer Brothers Construction Co. and Russell Standard Corp., bid \$1.3 million and \$1.6 million, re-

to vote on McCormick's paving contract at its 25 meeting.

The contract is for nearly \$3.3 million for a street repair plan, won by Mayor Joe S.

City officials said the project will cover 148,000 sq ft and 21 lane miles. There are 113 individual projects scheduled for this year.
